

CITY OF COCKRELL HILL, TEXAS
ORDINANCE 2008- A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COCKRELL HILL, TEXAS CALLING A MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR MAYOR AND COUNCIL PLACES ONE AND TWO AND DECLARING AN ELECTION JUDGE.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 8th day of January, 2008, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cockrell Hill, Texas passed the following election order:

SECTION 1: IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an election shall be held in the City of Cockrell Hill, Texas on the 10th Day of May, 2008 for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Council Members to fill the full terms of Mayor and Alderman Place 1, and Alderman Place 2, for a term of two (2) years, serving until their successors have been elected and qualified.

SECTION 2: Early voting shall be conducted by the Dallas County Elections Administrator, Bruce R. Sherbet, who is hereby appointed as the Early Voting Clerk and Charlene Farquhar, Early Voting Manager of the Dallas County Elections Department, is hereby appointed as Chief Deputy Early Voting Clerk, said voting to be conducted by the office of the Elections Department. The main voting polling place is Dallas County Records Building, Office of the Elections Department, First Floor, 509 Main Street, Dallas TX 75202.

SECTION 3: The polling place for Precinct 4300 for the early voting period and on the regular Election Day in 2008 shall be the City of Cockrell Hill City Hall, 4125 W. Clarendon, Cockrell Hill, Texas.

SECTION 4: Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted in accordance with the Joint Election Agreement and Service Contract between the City and Dallas County Elections Department and is tentatively as follows:

Monday	April 28, 2008 thru Friday, May 2, 2008	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Saturday	May 3, 2008	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Sunday	May 4, 2008	1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Monday	May 5, 2008 thru Tuesday, May 6, 2008	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Election Day hours on May 10th will be 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 5: All requests for early voting ballots by mail that are received by participating authorities will be transported by runner on the day of receipt to the Dallas County Elections Department, 8th Floor, Health and Human Service Building, 2377 North Stemmons Freeway, Dallas, Texas 75207 for processing. Persons voting by mail will send their voted ballots to the Dallas County Elections Department.

SECTION 6: All resident qualified electors of the City of Cockrell Hill shall be permitted to vote in said election. In addition, the election material enumerated in the Texas Election Code shall be printed in both English and Spanish for the use at the polling place and for early voting in said election.


SECTION 7: The Office of the Elections Department, 2377 North Stemmons Freeway, Suite 820, Dallas Texas 75207, is hereby established as the Central Count Station to receive and tabulate votes for said election.

SECTION 8: Note of this election shall be given by publication, as required by law.

SECTION 9: That the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be severable and that if the validity of any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

SECTION 10: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
