

CHAPTER 73: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE I. PROHIBITED LEFT TURN.

It shall be prohibited for the operator of any motor vehicle to turn left from the west bound lane of the 4500 block of Jefferson Boulevard.

SCHEDULE II. DESIGNATION OF ONE-WAY STREET.

Between the hours of 7:30 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. on days when the Dallas Independent School District is holding class, the flow of traffic in the 1200 block of Phinney Avenue, bounded by the Cockrell Hill corporate limits on the south, and the centerline of Kernack Avenue on the north shall be one-way in a northerly direction only. During the above stated time, it shall be unlawful for an individual to operate a motor vehicle or vehicle in the 1200 block of Phinney Avenue, as defined, in a southerly direction. At all other times, the flow of traffic shall be two-way in both a northerly and southerly direction within the above-defined limits of the 1200 block of Phinney Avenue.

SCHEDULE III. MAXIMUM LIMITS ON SPECIFIC STREETS.

The authorized maximum speed on Jefferson Boulevard within the corporate city limits of the city is set at 35 miles per hour.

SCHEDULE IV. DESIGNATION OF SCHOOL ZONES.

(A) In the following listed blocks of public streets or highways within the city, 20 miles per hour shall be the prima facie maximum speed limit for the operation of motor vehicles, and any speed in excess thereof shall be prima facie evidence that the speed is not reasonable or prudent and that it is unlawful:

- (1) 3500 to 4000 block of Virginia Boulevard.
- (2) 3700 to 4400 block of Higgins Avenue.
- (3) 400 to 500 block of Andrews Avenue.

(B) Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m., and from 2:15 p.m. until 4:30 p.m., on days when the Dallas Independent School District is holding class, the following designated blocks of public streets or highways within the corporate limits of the city are designated as school zones:

- (1) 3800 to 3900 block of Meredith Avenue.
- (2) 1200 block of Phinney Avenue.

(C) No person shall operate a motor vehicle in the 3800 to 3900 blocks of Meredith Avenue, which is a public street or highway within the corporate limits of the city, on a school day at a speed greater than 20 miles per hour during the hours from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

(D) Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on days when the Dallas Independent School District is holding classes, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle upon the following public streets or highways within the corporate limits of the city at a speed greater than 20 miles per hour:

- (1) Cockrell Hill Road from 50 feet north of the center of the intersection of Clarendon Drive with Cockrell Hill Road to the intersection of the south city limits with Cockrell Hill Road.
- (2) Cockrell Hill Road from 50 feet north of the center of the intersection of Lakehurst Court with Cockrell Hill Road to 50 feet south of the intersection of Garfield Avenue with Cockrell Hill Road.
- (3) Kernack Street from the western city limits to the eastern city limits.
- (4) Meredith Street from 200 feet west of the center of the intersection of Meredith Street with Red Bud Lane to 200 feet west of the center of the intersection of Gilpin Avenue with Meredith Street.

(5) Phinney Avenue from 50 feet south of the center of the intersection of Clarendon Drive with Phinney Avenue to the southern city limits.
